RULES AND CONDITIONS of W.S.D.F.

1. No one is to approach the Adjudicator & the Adjudicators decision will be final.
2. Any Protest must be lodged with a fee of \$20:00 within 15 minutes of completion of section (said fee will be forfeited if protest is dismissed.)
3. No responsibility will be accepted for any injuries or losses incurred by competitors or any persons attending the festival, please don't leave valuables in change rooms.
4. Time Limits apply *Dance Sections - 3 minutes* except *S/ Dance - 4 minutes*
Troupes - 5 minutes
Singing Sections 12/u - 3 minutes, 13-21 years- 4 minutes, Groups - 5minutes
5. **CD** One track/routine per CD including Championships , marked with section and competitor's no. We recommend a back up in case of problems.***No stickers on CD's. CD's with more than 1 Track or stickers will not be played !***
6. Troupes must contain no less than 4 competitors & each school can only enter a maximum of 4 times in any section.
7. Restricted is for competitors who have not won a 1st place in that category at any eisteddfod or festival.
8. No tapes with singing (vocals) can be used in Song & Dance, Demi-Character or Classical sections. No background tapping allowed on CD's in Tap sections.
9. No repeating of routines/songs is allowed, other than Scholarships also 10/u Championships & Babies Championship may repeat one (1) routine only
10. **Improvisations**, plain single (one) color, form fitting dance gear must be worn ***No skirts, Hair must be in a bun NO ornaments or decorations of any description to be worn & no school logo's allowed.*** Competitors must report in & be marked off 10 minutes prior to start of section
11. Competitors entering championships render themselves ineligible to enter restricted sections in the category of the same championship other than babies.
12. Competitors must abide by all qualification rules to compete in Championships & Scholarships
13. Competitors must enter and compete in their own age group, **NO** dancing above age is allowed. ***Persons over the age of 18*** receiving income from tuition or performance of singing or dancing are ***ineligible*** to compete.
14. Competitors must submit music & song/routine details & **report backstage** prior to commencement of section, and be ready to perform in their designated position.
15. ***No dancing out of section*** will be permitted unless extreme circumstances and with prior committee approval this includes performing at other events.

RULES AND CONDITIONS continued.

16. **Large sections** that have been **split to (A) & (B) sections** for the benefit of competitors will not be altered; **swapping sections will not be permitted.**
17. **Note;** Winners of last year's scholarships are ineligible to compete this year in the same category that they won last year.
18. The committee reserves the right to combine or cancel any section.
19. A professional video is available and **NO** private **video or still cameras** are permitted in the hall.
20. **Hall Rules**
 - A:** Owing to privacy laws mobile & camera phones should be turned off before entering change room or hall.
 - B:** **No animals** allowed in **hall or change rooms**, no HAY BALES or like materials (flammable, toxic, breakable e.g. glass) permitted in hall and **no rosin** to be used as these have been banned by school officials.
 - C: Props** All props are the responsibility of the competitor. Backstage manager will assist if required. *Props may be placed backstage & must be removed from the hall at the end of each section !!!!!*
21. **Responsibility for correct entry rests with the entrant!** An incorrect entry will result in forfeiture of entry fee and inability to compete in the correct section.
22. **No refunds** will be given after closing date.
23. For uniformity any competitor who's name is not listed in the program for what ever reason will be required to dance at the beginning of the section
24. Cheque's that are dishonored must be replaced by cash or bank cheque plus any fees & costs incurred
25. **All changing, make-up & hair** must be done in the **change room**
26. *It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure they adhere to all copyright laws!*
27. The committee has the right to decide on any matter not covered by these rules and the decision of the committee will be final.

4. Must compete in 2 singing sections to qualify for championship
5. Must compete in 2 singing section to qualify for Scholarship
6. No one is to approach the Adjudicator & the Adjudicators decision will be final.
7. Any Protest must be lodged with a fee of \$20:00 within 15 minutes of completion of section (fee will be forfeited if protest is dismissed.)
8. Time Limits apply to all singing sections & will be timed
 - 8/u, 10/u, 12/u, - 3 minutes
 - 14/u, 16/u, 17-21 yrs - 4 minutes
 - Vocal Group - 5 minutes
